La Salle EMCI is located in the
Rhone Alpes Auvergne region
in France and belongs to the
Lasallian network.

It offers a 5 - year programme
dedicated to international trade,
specifically combining theoretical
concepts, case studies and
strategic vision.

The courses offered in English
and in French alternate with
in-company work periods.

The curriculum is aimed at
students open to the global world.

The quality of the programme can
be assessed by the capacity of the
young graduates to carry out real
internationally-oriented missions.

La Salle EMCI is part of the La Salle
Campus with over 300 students.

The school is located
in a pleasant environment
in the center of Saint-Etienne
closed to the Pilat regional Park.

exchange program taught in english

La Salle EMCI offers
an exchange program taught
in English to its foreign students.
Students can choose courses
from Year 3 (Bachelor Program)
and Year 5 (Master
Program) curriculum.

La Salle EMCI undergraduate program Bachelor

is a 3-year-degree-program in International
Business. It provides students with a unique
combination of theoretical and practical
skills. Students learn to, develop, implement,
and manage International Business.
They have a 6-month minimum internship
period to carry out during their studies.

La Salle EMCI postgraduate program Master

is a 2-year-masters-program in International
Management. Students learn to manage
and organize business units abroad, plan
international logistics, understand risks
and adapt to the geopolitical environment.
The last year is a sandwich course
with a specialisation to be ready for a career
in international business.

All courses are directly linked to international trade and business.

duration

The exchange runs from September to December (4 months for 30 ECTS credits).

Integration of students is in the Autumn semester. Students can extend their mobility to the Spring semester, partly at school and in companies, they will be able to gain 30 ECTS credits.

practical information

Accommodation

There is no student residence within the school but there are several located in the city of Saint Etienne. It is very easy and inexpensive to find accommodation in the city.

Cost of Living

The estimated monthly budget to live in Saint Etienne for a student is approximately 500 to 600 euros including accommodation, food and transportation.

Language requirements

Good level of English (B2 level at least) and a reasonably good level of French (B1 level)
Application deadline for Autumn and Spring semester: July 1st.

saint etienne, a city of design saint etienne, a student city

Each year over 28,000 students come to study in Saint Etienne. The city has numerous higher education colleges and organises various events to integrate its foreign students. This helps them discover the city, its culture and fosters exchanges between students.

The population of the Saint Etienne area is about 400,000 inhabitants. The city has undergone an industrial shift (from firearms, mines, cycles and ribbons). Since 2010, the city has been the first to be awarded "the city of Design" label by UNESCO (United Nations Educational, Scientific and cultural Organization) in France.

This can be seen in the designer buildings and open spaces in the city. The city also hosts a dedicated international event every 2 years: the Biennale Internationale du design.

Saint Etienne is also a cultural city with its many festivals throughout the year. The colour of the city is green in reference to its urban parks, the natural environment surrounding the city and its famous ASSE football team.
